Committee member, Lynne Rawson, recently returned from Nepal where she successfully negotiated Memorandums of Understanding with Bhim Kumar, Nepali manager of FONA Education Scholarship Program, and Rajan Bishwokarma, Chairperson of the Deprived Women & Children Upliftment Centre (DMUK) & Ishwor Ghimire, Managing Director of the David Rajan Memorial International School. (DRMIS)

During her visit, Lynne launched our scholarship program at a celebration dinner, where the scholarship recipients were delighted to receive their Scholarship Certificates &, for the first time in their lives, a welcome scarf Lynne had bought for them. None had ever experienced this traditional Nepali welcome before & it was a highlight of their evening.

Despite the challenges of the monsoon season, Lynne visited students' hostels & campuses, to meet staff & check student progress & welfare. She is delighted to report that all students are doing well in their studies & that all are extremely grateful for the support from sponsors & our fundraising efforts. Some are facing health challenges & Lynne was able to arrange eye testing & glasses for one student & leave funds for medical expenses for ongoing treatment of ankle & leg problems two boys are experiencing.

We are very appreciative of the efforts Lynne made on our behalf & all that she managed to achieve in her 2 week stay. We are very fortunate that both Lynne & Ainsley have been able to visit Nepal to oversee the successful establishment & ongoing monitoring of the scholarship program in collaboration with Bhim. These regular visits are integral to our success.

Our thoughts are with scholarship student Manju who is sitting 3 days of examinations for entry into Kathmandu School of Law this week. Good luck Manju!





Education Sponsor Program at DMUK & DRMIS.

Lynne visited the Orphanage & school twice during her busy visit & was able to negotiate a new MOU with them regarding the sponsorship program. When we incorporated as an association, we narrowed our purpose to education support only, & the sponsorship funds will now be applied to fee support for Orphanage children & some local children, to attend either DRMIS or other colleges, depending on their class level. Rajan presented

FONA with a beautiful gold framed portrait of a goddess, which Ainsley will display proudly at her Centre.

Lynne reports that the school is doing very well with over 150 enrolled students, & that all the children are happy & healthy. She & Leanne were treated to a welcome ceremony & shared a meal with the children, which was a great joy for them.



Lynne used sponsorship funds to purchase food & clothing for the children & stationary supplies for the school. Further funds will be allocated on receipt of updated information about the children, their class level, school & exam fees etc. which Ishwor is in the process of preparing. Lynne also brought back school progress reports for some of the children, which will shortly be posted to lucky sponsors.



Meet Sandeep Bishwokarma.

Sandeep is our latest scholarship recipient. He is a talented artist & recently achieved over 95% in his entrance exam & was accepted into Sirjana College

of Fine Arts. He hopes to eventually become an artist in the army. Lynne was able to enrol him in the course, buy supplies, books & uniform, & identify a hostel where he will live when he moves out of the Orphanage shortly. He will share a room with our accountancy student Bishal.

This is our biggest fundraiser so we need your support!


It's always a great night where you have fun, help others & learn about the impact your support is having on the lives of these severely disadvantaged children.


Mark your calendars for September 15 for our next Movie Fundraiser!
