Nepal Orphanage & School Update.




Malcolm Lindquist, chairperson of the RAWCS project, recently returned from a whirlwind trip to Nepal to celebrate the second anniversary of the newly repaired School building! He was delighted to be able to sign off on all school building repairs & to report that the Orphanage buildings have also been completely repaired & are now fully operational. The blockade has been lifted & life is becoming much easier for these beautiful people.

The children performed cultural songs & dances at the ceremony & were a credit to the talents & dedication of the teachers.

Malcolm reported that many schools continue to suffer from the devastation of the earthquake, with enrolments down & jobs scarce. People cannot afford to send their children to school. As a result, three of the schools with which we have close connections, Surodaya, Blue Sky & Ananda Bhumi, have merged under one management team. The 3 campuses still operate separately as junior, senior & boarding schools. Malcolm has started preliminary discussions about the Orphanage school, newly named the "David Rusk & Rajan Memorial School" becoming part of this exciting project. There would be many benefits for the Orphanage children & school staff if this plan is successful. We will keep you all updated on this exciting development.

We have enjoyed a very positive & productive working relationship with Bhim & cannot speak highly enough of his integrity & commitment to the children over the past very challenging months. We are not losing him completely as he acting on our behalf, as a mentor to the two young men who recently left the Orphanage to begin university studies.
