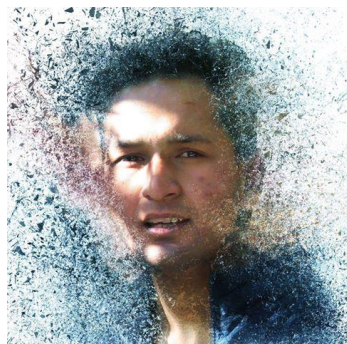

Bishal's course fees are paid by NGO Children's Future Fund in Germany.



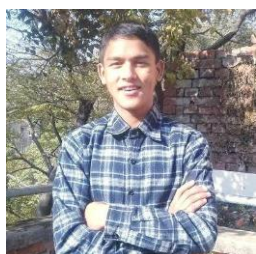
