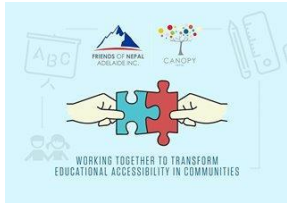
We raised over \$2,200 at this event & thanks go to Lynne Rawson, our amazing fundraising chairperson, for all her efforts also!

We farewelled Bhim & his MMSD-N team, in a final meeting with the students, & were also fortunate to meet Bhim's new wife & learn about their plans for the future. We were guests of honour at our coordinator's Rajeev's graduation from Cocina Mitho Chha as we stayed at the bed & breakfast associated with the cooking school.



Another highlight was the visit with the **Child Development Society** to see the beautiful women involved in the SEEP (Self Employment through Education) program who proudly spoke of how they have learned to read, write & calculate over the past 12 months, as well as start microbusinesses. We were privileged to hand over the seed money for the start of new businesses.

Inspiring! We are making plans for further support of this project & of the CDS Day Care programs for the children of day laborers in very poor areas. Watch this space!

Vists to both the **Rotary & Rotaract Clubs of Dilibazaar** enabled us to present the \$1,000 donated to **Child Development Society** by the **Rotary Club of Blackwood** & it was more excitement, especially for Denise who helped pack these boxes, when the 4 pallets of books we collaborated with **South Pacific School Aid, the Rotary Clubs of Adelaide, Blackwood, & Brownhill Creek, Unley High School & Pulteney Grammar**, arrived. Despite the monsoon weather all boxes were intact! It was hard to know who was smiling more, Prem, the Canopy team, the Rotaractors or Denise, as the books were sorted for delivery to the Rotaract prison library, the Canopy Nepal community library & other local school libraries.
