Sanjeev & Bishal will complete their Bachelor studies in May & October 2019! They will be our first students to graduate with Bachelors in IT & Business Studies. We are excited to see how the education scholarship support they have received over the past 3 years will change their lives. Our three girls are also doing well! Anjana completes her final Diploma in fashion design exams next month & will, thanks to the generosity of our partner donor The Children's Fund, transit to Bachelor studies in January 2019. FONAI will extend her scholarship to support her living costs for the duration of her studies. We are delighted that she is now living with the family of her Internship mentor Nirmala, & working part time in her fashion boutique. Shrinkinhala has successfully completed her Year 11 semester 1 exams.

Self Employment through Education Program Update.

The first three groups FONAI has facilitated support for recently completed their training & established their core businesses of buffalo farming. The groups are continuing to use savings & seed money to finance new businesses put forward by members. Strong links have been established with local & government groups to make the project sustainable. Two new groups are currently being formed. Unfortunately our recent application for a DFAT Friendship Grant to further support this program was unsuccessful. We will try again for the next round in 2019.
