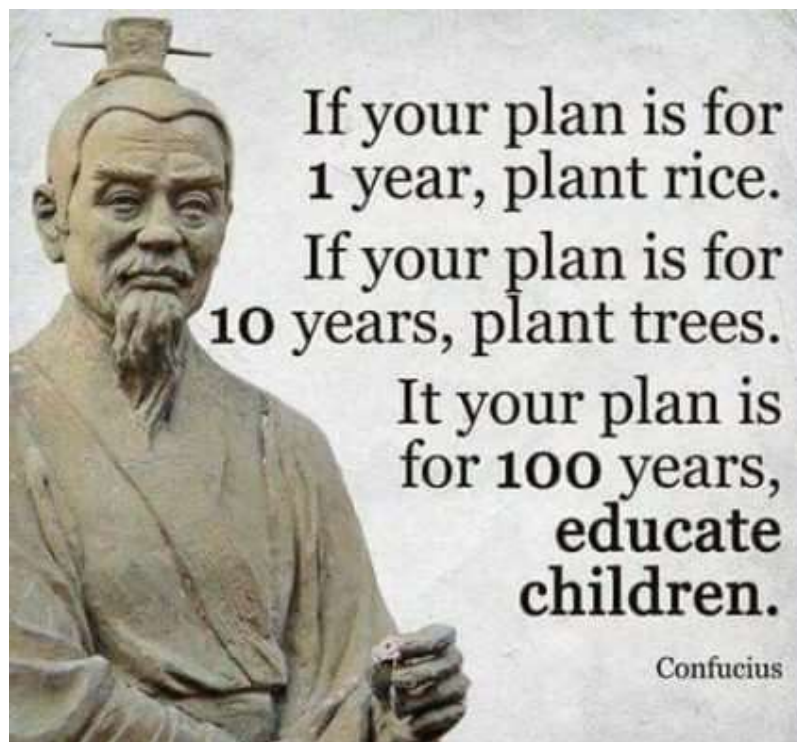

ABOUT US.

"Friends of Nepal- Adelaide Inc. (FONAI) is a registered Australian charity. We began our scholarship program in 2013, following a visit to Nepal & seeing first hand how disadvantage of birth is perpetuated by lack of educational opportunities.

Education in Nepal - Background to FONAI's work.

Formal school education in Nepal officially spans a period of 12 years, at the successful completion of which a student graduates with a certificate of Higher Secondary Education. Official government policy is for free education to year 12, but the reality is that Year 10 remains the highest level of education for most Nepalese people.

Students who wish to continue higher education, years 11 & 12, must attend private schools which are relatively expensive and out of reach of most of the students in the program.

FONAI's decision to focus funding support for these young people to achieve higher levels of education requires a long term commitment from our group & our donors.

FESSHIP graduates often require short term help as they enter unpaid internships to complete course requirements.

It requires us to limit the number of scholarships we can sustain as students may require support for up to 5 years.

Without our support, these young people would not be able to continue their studies & would face uncertain futures.

A FONAI education scholarship is a life changing opportunity for these young people.

Our Mission

FONAI views higher education as a catalyst, an agent of change for individuals, families and communities.

Our mission is to provide access to senior and post secondary education to marginalised, socially and economically disadvantaged Nepali youth who otherwise would not have the financial means to fulfil their educational goals.

To succeed in our mission we:

- Promote and provide financial support for senior and post secondary education via an education scholarship program
- Assure that students have all the information and support necessary to make sound educational and financial decisions about their futures
- Lead a collaborative network of educational partners aligned to support student selection, preparation, transition and persistence to course completion.

- FONAI is partnered with Child Development Society (CDS) in Nepal to facilitate funding for Self Employment Education Program for illiterate women in remote villages in Nepal.

MONITORING FESSHIP PROGRAM

FONAI members visit Nepal regularly to monitor programs.

Volunteering

FONAI has close associations with many schools & charitable organisations in Nepal.

FONAI requires that all adults who visit FESSHIP programs have a current police clearance & sign a code of conduct prior to visiting programs.

Eligibility Criteria for the Education Scholarship Program. (FESSHIP)

Applications are invited from Nepali residents who:

- Were born and currently reside in Nepal
- Are aged between 16 and 20 at the time of application –
- Can demonstrate significant disadvantage in their personal and/or family situation or education opportunities
- Are not receiving funding from any other donor source.
- Commit to complete the specified program supported by the educational scholarship in Nepal.



FESSHIP Program

- The number of scholarships is subject to available funding
- Funding is capped at \$2,000 per scholarship.
- Funding can be applied to course fees &/or living costs.
- FESSHIP management supports deserving students who do not have a place to live cannot live by securing them suitable accommodation.
- Funding can only be applied to study in Nepal.

Priority for scholarships is to:

- achieve gender balance in the program
- support students from marginalised communities

Wellbeing Workshops

FONAI funds wellness workshops conducted by our management team to support students to independent living.

Workshops covered include, but are not limited to:

- Financial literacy
- Sexual health
- Emotional Resilience
- Career counselling
- Social media – safe usage

Education Scholarship Details

- Education Scholarships are a minimum of \$500 annually.
- Sponsorships can be paid in full or in two instalments.
- All funding is applied to support educational costs and identified care and health needs of scholarship students.
- FONAI retains no more than 5% of each scholarship to cover administration costs, including insurance, money transfer fees and the maintenance of our web site.
- Sponsors receive regular communication from FONAI about the program.

Other Funding Opportunities.

FONAI welcomes partnership support from corporations, individuals, &/or service clubs who prefer short term funding for:

- One off donations for specific or general items
- Vocational/ study support programs

Our management team counsels & advises students who wish to pursue short term courses in fields like hospitality, tourism, languages etc., & enters into partnership agreements with approved providers of such training.
