We have supported Sanjeev in partnership with Children's Future Fund in Germany for 4 years, from when he was living at the orphanage to this proud day. He will graduate on Sep 3. It's result time in Nepal & we expect our accounting student **Bishal** to be our next graduate. Bishal is completing his final year of a Bachelor in Accounting & eagerly awaiting his results.

We can proudly announce that both **Hem & Prachandra** have successfully completed Year 12! This is a major achievement as only 25% of eligible Nepalis reach this level of education.

Bijay, pictured in the hat, who also studied Year 12, missed out on a final pass & will complete supplementary exams shortly to reach this milestone. Bijay battled serious health issues, he had typhoid fever, during his studies, & we are proud that he made it through these two demanding years.



All 3 boys are now studying vocational classes, Hem medical preparation, Prachandra, University preparation & Bijay, hospitality studies. Bijay has already completed his Barista training & is now on the cooking part of his course. His verdict! I love it! Hem & Prachandra will make their final university choices in October. Exciting times!
