Lockdown in Nepal.

Restrictions are gradually being lifted in Nepal after 3 months of total lockdown.

Night time curfews remain. Migrant workers are returning en masse, causing many issues with the spread of COVID19. The number of identified cases is rapidly growing and with limited and unreliable testing, crowded housing and extreme poverty, the situation is dire for many people.

This week our intrepid FESSHIP team was finally able to visit the office and the bank for the first time since the end of March!

Our manager, Deekshak, has been in weekly contact with all of the students and the team is planning to assist them in every way possible once their needs become clearer, and as lockdown conditions are lifted.

FESSHIP Scholarship Program News.

The students are still in their villages waiting for resumption of their studies, currently scheduled for mid July. Our team is not confident that this will occur. All are well, and some have managed to continue their studies on line.

Recently the team visited our student Sushant, who has been living at SAB hostel, and provided him with supplies and a food parcel. Sushant recently learned that the secondary education examinations, (SEE) have been cancelled and his SAB school marks will be his final grade. These results are very important and will determine whether he is able to complete years 11 and 12 when schools reopen. Sushant plans to return to his village in this interim period. Other students completing Year 12 and higher studies are still waiting for the government decision about exams and the resumption of their studies. This will not be an easy year for our team, our scholars or our many Nepali friends.



Partnership Agreement 2020-2022



Due to the uncertainty around the students' ability to resume or progress their studies, and their return dates to Kathmandu, we have made some changes in our new partnership agreement with our Canopy team.

Traditionally we have had a one year agreement, July 1 – June 30, following our financial year dates.

To provide more flexibility in planning, we are committing to a 2 year partnership agreement.

Our goal is to enable the team scope to more easily adapt the program to provide the support required for a likely staggered return to studies for the students.
